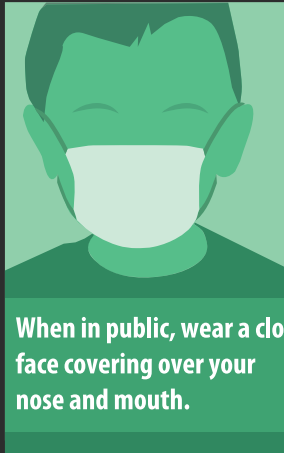

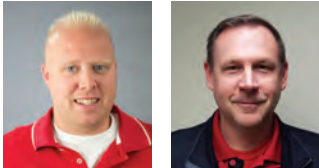

The car community is a tight-knit group, often coming together to support “one of their own” in times of need. That solidarity led to Carlisle Events teaming up with Driven to Cure (DTC). Founded by car enthusiast Andrew Lee, DTC is a non-profit established to help raise awareness and provide funding for the research of rare kidney cancers like Hereditary Leiomyomatosis and Renal Cell Cancer (HLRCC) in children and young adults. Lee passed away on Easter Sunday, April 21, 2019 after a long and courageous battle with HLRCC. Despite his passing, the cause forges on with events, fundraisers, etc. and has raised \$600,000 in three years for research.

DRIVE-THROUGH JUDGING TAKES PLACE ON SATURDAY

Showfield

All Showfield participants (including judged and non-judged) must check in at the Guest Services building to get their goody bag and dash card. There are three parking options: registered Showfield vehicles may park with their country of manufacture, their club or in the Open Showfield. See map.

Judging

JUDGING BY EJUDGED.COM

To be judged, a Showfield vehicle must be registered as Judged Showfield. The vehicle may be parked as described above because judging is done in a drive-through format at the Pavilion on Saturday. Check the judging time for your make of vehicle on page 28. Drive your vehicle to the judging area 15 minutes before your judging time. Judging standards are on pages 29 and 30.

If you want to change from non-judged to judged at the event, you may do so at the Registration Office outside of Gate 3 and pay an additional fee of \$25.

Carlisle Elite Judging

Our staff will choose ten vehicles from the Showfield to receive Carlisle Elite awards on Friday. To be eligible, all you need to do is have your registered vehicle parked anywhere on the Showfield. Winners are presented with their awards as they are selected.

Club Challenge & Coolest Club

We've challenged clubs to see who has the most vehicles here. The top three receive awards. Additionally, we offer free rental of a tent to those who have 25+ vehicles. There is also an award for the Coolest Club Hangout, which is determined by our staff.

Winners List & Awards

Winners of the Judged Showfield and club challenge will be posted on the Winners' List at 9 AM Sunday outside of Guest Services/ Grandstand (8:30 AM online). After checking the list, winners should pick up their award in Guest Services.

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO BE HERE ON SUNDAY:

If you are unable to pick up your award, you have three options:

- 1) Pick it up during another event (for up to one year);
- 2) Pick it up at our office Mon.-Fri. 8 AM - 5 PM; or
- 3) Pay to have it shipped to you.

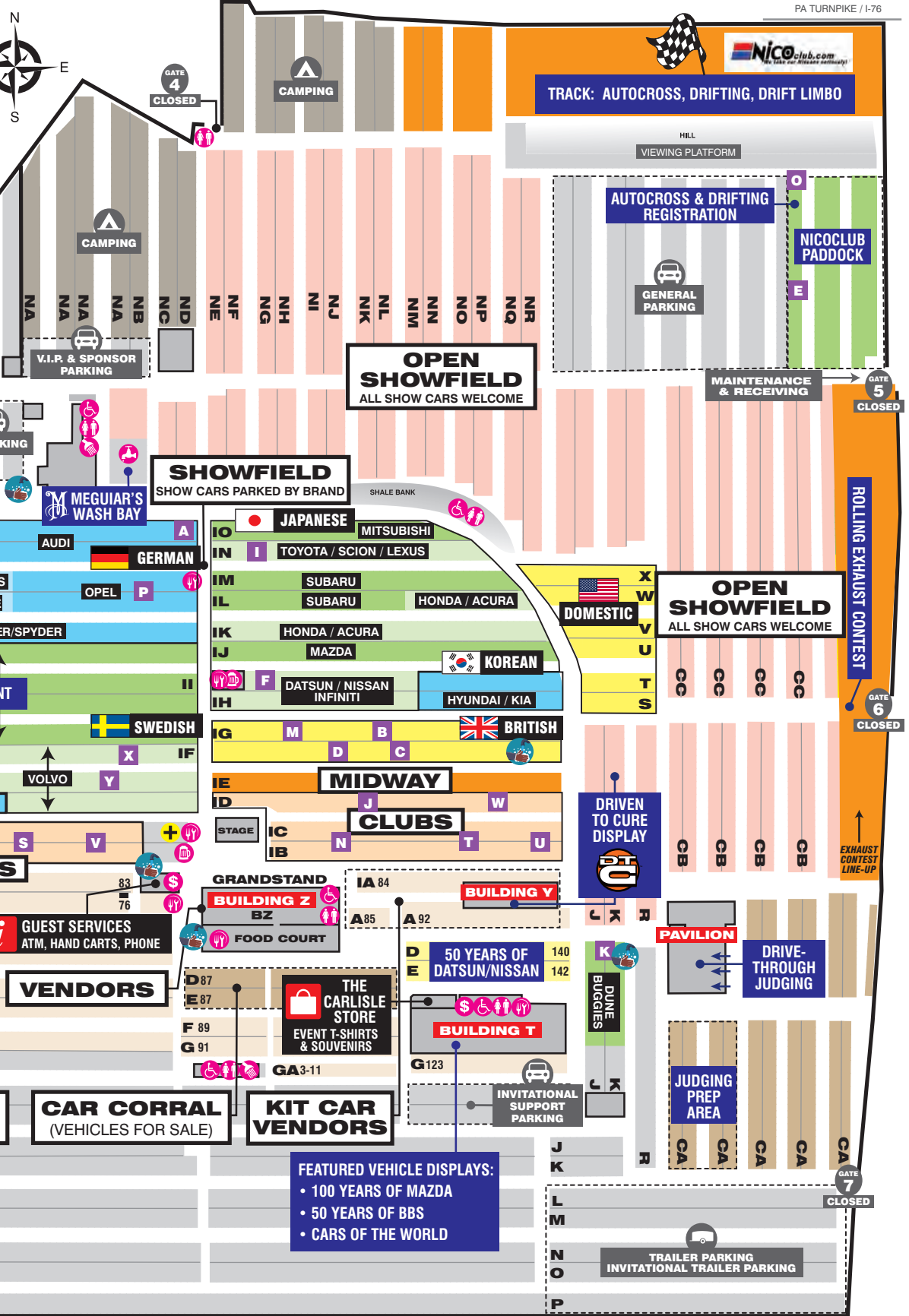

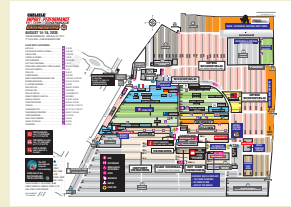

Exterior

Body & Paint: 10 POINTS

This category is based on panel alignment & straightness, body kit (fitment, rarity of product, etc.), paint/glass condition, shaving, body part or lighting conversions, wide body, and/or any other custom bodywork.

Suspension: 5 POINTS

Type of suspension (static/air/etc). Also taking into consideration: attention to detail, ride height, undercarriage upgrades, fitment and finish of products, powdercoating/plating, install of air components.

Brakes: 5 POINTS

The judges are looking for big brake or custom brake upgrades. Are both the front and rear upgraded? Quality and rarity of product? Also taking into consideration any other braking accessories, brake lines, and custom finishes on the braking system.

Wheels & Tires: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on the uniqueness, rarity, and fitment of the wheels and tires. Also taking into consideration cleanliness and custom finishes.

Overall Quality: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on the overall execution of the vehicle's exterior. Scores will be based on attention to detail, use of color & unique finishes, graphics, quality of finish, accessory lighting, and cleanliness.

Engine Bay

Appearance & Performance: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on engine bolt-ons, custom fabrication, aspiration (turbo/supercharger/etc), motor swap, use of paint and or custom plating/finishing, cleanliness of wiring, nitrous oxide, accessories.

Overall Execution: 10 POINTS

Craftsmanship is key in this category. Judges will evaluate safety upgrades, performance engineering, one-off/custom parts, attention to detail, quality of plating/polishing/finishes, and most importantly level of difficulty (ie motor swap, turbo, shaved bay, wire tuck, rhd or rwd conversions, etc).

Interior

Passenger Compartment: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on the seating area - taking into consideration the condition and quality of dash, seats, accessories, unique features, roll cage or roll bar(s), use of fabric/materials, and overall upholstery.

Trunk - Entertainment vs. Motorsport Theme 10 POINTS

This is a progressive judging category which takes into consideration the theme of the vehicle build. In this category, motorsport or performance themed vehicles do not lose points for not including a custom audio/video install.

Audio/Show Car themed vehicles will be scored based on In Car Entertainment, audio install (visual), video sources and tv/monitors, quality/rarity of products, air suspension components installed in cargo area, etc.

Motorsport/Performance themed vehicles will be scored based on fuel cell install, roll cage components in trunk or rear suspension area, suspension components, strut bars, braces, safety equipment, quality/rarity of products, etc.

Overall Quality: 10 POINTS

Attention to detail, use of color/finishes, materials, fitment, cleanliness, fabrication, level of customization.

Show Quality



The Show Quality portion of the scoresheet is a comprehensive look at the build's overall execution and style. These two categories are judged based on the universal 5-star rating system. Those possible 10 stars count as the final 10 points of your overall score.

Originality/Uniqueness: 5 STARS
Rare vehicles or more common vehicles with unique modifications and rare parts will score higher.

Overall Execution: 5 STARS
Overall quality of build. Fitment throughout all aspects of vehicle. Does the vehicle flow? Is it period or era correct? Is it relevant to current trends? Is the vehicle still functional?

The overall score is based on a possible 100 TOTAL POINTS.

Stock, Restored & Preserved Vehicles:

Due to the unique format of Carlisle's Import & Performance Nationals, not all vehicles will fit strictly into the official "Judging Standards" score sheet. Vehicles that have been purposely kept stock for restoration or preservation purposes will be judged on slightly different criteria. All drivers must consider that they are competing against a flawless version of their build on a score sheet, rather than against the other competitors in their class, whether the vehicle is stock, subtle, or aggressively modified. Some classes may include both stock and modified vehicles.

Restored and preserved vehicles will be judged on the same visual areas of their vehicles – *Exterior, Engine Compartment, Interior/Trunk, Overall Execution, etc.* Deductions can be given for imperfections in paint/materials, scratches, general dirty upkeep, etc. Further deductions can be given for bolt-ons and custom modifications as well. If you are building a restoration project, you must keep in mind that all aspects of the build must be "period correct" for age of the vehicle. A properly restored vehicle should now once again have the appearance of a show room vehicle from its original production date – with zero or few aftermarket modifications. A preserved vehicle may show some age, but should still overall maintain its factory show room appearance. Replacement parts should be "period correct" and should be OEM equipment.

Deductions and scoring will be weighed accordingly, so that stock (restored and preserved) vehicles that appear in the same classes as modified vehicles, will be considered on a level playing field for placement within the final results. The event judging staff has gone through a training and selection process to be a part of this event.

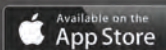

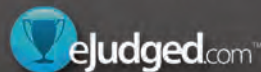

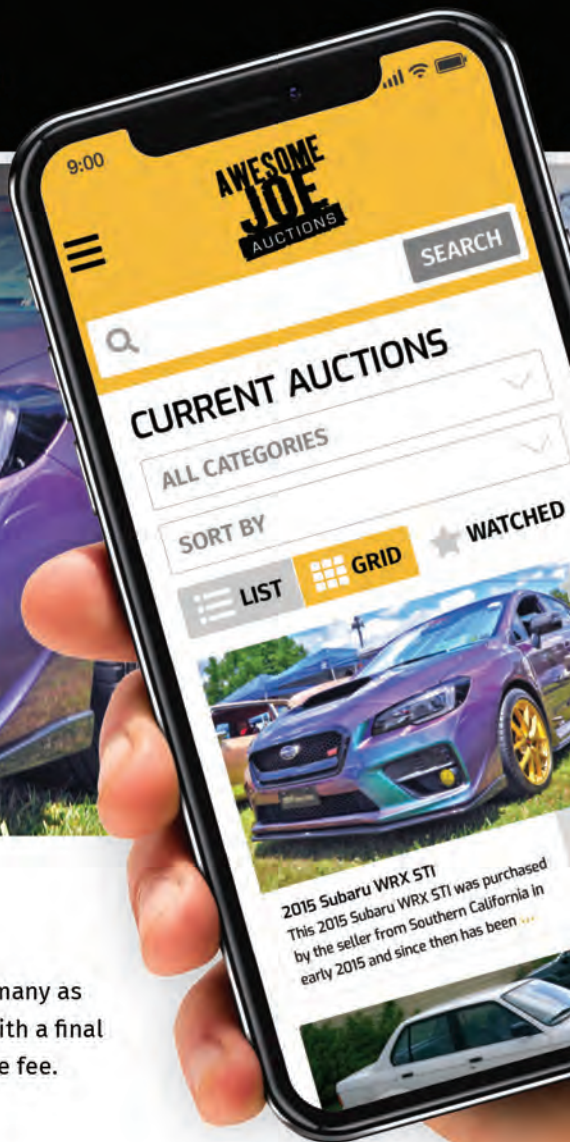
